Important Dates

- Deadline to Enter:December 6th, 2018
- Exhibition Dates: January 11th, 2019 - February 23rd, 2019
- Artist Notification:December 8th, 2018
- Shipping deadline of work to Blue Line Arts: January 5th 3pm, 2019
- Hand deliver work to Blue Line Arts:January 6th & 7th from 10am to 3pm
- Opening Reception:January 19th, 2019 5pm to 8:30pm
- Closing Reception:February 16th, 2019 5pm to 8:30pm
- Pick up unsold work from Blue Line Arts:February 24th & 25th 10am to 3pm

Eligibility

- Open to all artists
- All artwork must be original and completed within the last two years
- Artwork cannot have been previously exhibited at Blue Line Arts
- All 2-D works must be ready to hang
- All artwork must be for sale
- Accepted artwork that differs significantly from image in online submission will be disqualified
- No accepted entry may be withdrawn or sold outside of the exhibition prior to the closing date
- Blue Line Arts handles all sales transactions. Non-member artists receive a 50% commission from all gallery sales and Artist-level members receive a 60% commission
- Size limitations
 - Art must be no more than 24” in width
- The artist is responsible to pay for all shipping and should provide a prepaid label from FedEx or UPS (Not USPS) for return of artwork

- Applicants must apply online using the application form below. There is a \$35 fee for non-members, Artist-level members may apply free of charge.

Application Requirements: Applicants must apply using the form on the Blue Line Arts website, <http://www.bluelinearts.org/call-to-artists>. You must be 18 years or older to apply.
